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Grounding



Family Café Style



- You are seated at one of the tables.
- Notice each table has a question, flip chart paper and markers.
- You will have the opportunity to share your thoughts and ideas around three different questions (one at each table).
- There will be two opportunities to move to another table and answer each question during the session.




Process

- 15 minutes will be spent responding to each question.
- Timekeeper will prompt you to move to a different question/table.
- Remember to add thoughts, comments, and drawings to the already existing thoughts, comments and drawings on the flip chart paper.

Let's get started.....




- One person from the table reads the question.
- Someone can be the scribe and write down a key point on the flip chart paper of what arises from the discussion about what you've learned on this topic from the conference.
- Comments can be in written words, doodles, pictures, etc.
- Everyone participates with the discussion.

- Each host will report out on the discussion questions from each table.
